Using the Philly Scientists Mobile App

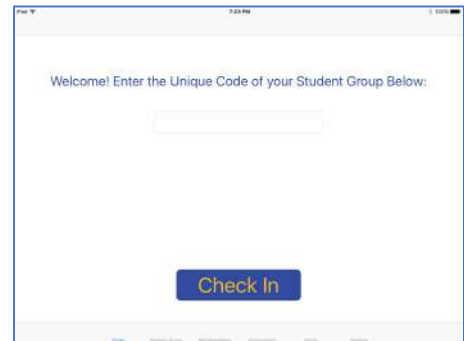
Description:

This document will guide teachers and students in using the Philly Scientists iOS mobile app.

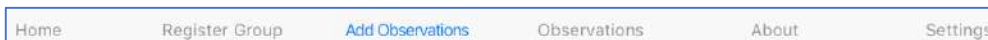
Registering a Group:

The Philly Scientists allows student groups to record observations of animal, plant, and insect species in their community. Student groups will receive a Group Code from their teachers to use with the app.

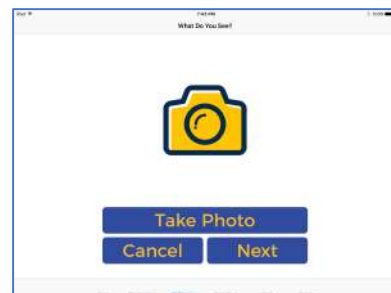
1. Register your Group with the Philly Scientist app by using the Group Code supplied by your teacher.



2. Click on the "Add Observations" link in the bottom menu.



3. Click on the "Take Photo" button to take a picture of the item your group would like to observe.
4. Click "Next" to continue.



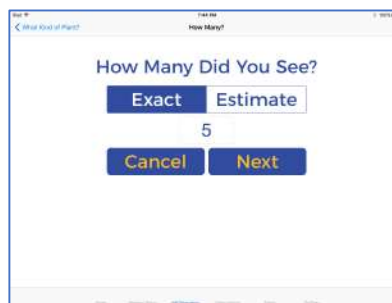
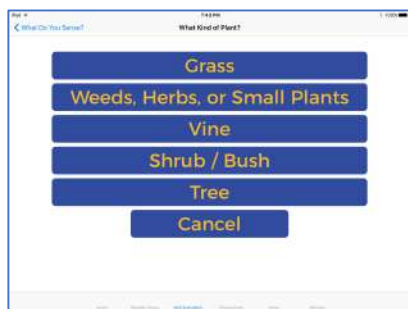
5. How did you sense it? Select the different senses you used to find your Observation.



6. What did you find? Select the option that describes what you found.



7. Continue through the menu to select the species and other choices the best relate to what your group found.



8. Add a note to record any other information that would help describe your observation. Click "Done" to complete your Observation.



Sending Observations to PhillyScientists.com:

The information you record outside of your school is not saved to Philly Scientists website automatically as you don't always have an internet connection. Follow the instructions below to send your observation data to PhillyScientists.com. **You will need to be connected to the Internet via wifi for this to work!**

1. Click on the "Observations" button in the bottom menu.
2. Review your Observations. (You can click on an Observation to edit the information if necessary.)
3. Click on the "Send" button to send your Observations to the phillyscientists.com website.
